

A Checklist of Flora at Indianhouse Mountain

This list specific to Indianhouse Mountain, from tidewater to summit, includes records from previous hikers, Alaska Native Plant Society field trips, and UAA herbarium specimens. It is sorted by scientific names consistent with the 2020 Flora of Alaska Project, updated from Hulten's 1968 *Flora of Alaska and Neighboring Territories*. Lichens, mosses, and fungi are included after vascular plants.
