

Checklist of Early Flora at Windy Corner

This list includes records specifically for spring at Windy Corner from hikers, participants in Alaska Native Plant Society field trips, and specimens held at the University of Alaska Anchorage Herbarium. It is sorted by scientific names consistent with the 2020 Flora of AK Project and cross-referenced to Hulten's 1968 *Flora of Alaska and Neighboring Territories*. Lichens, mosses, and fungi are included after vascular plants.
